

The Faris Family Military Youth Scholarship

Award: The winner will be awarded \$5,000 based on financial need and personal merit.

Eligibility:

Individuals aged 16-19 who are:

- a) enrolled or desire to enroll in a two- or four-year program in an accredited college or vocational-technical/ trades school;
 - b) have or anticipate award of a high school diploma or GED in the 2025 calendar year; and
 - c) have a parent(s) currently assigned to Joint Base (JB MDL) on active duty.
- d) Faris Family and Impact Charity Services employees/family members are ineligible.

Application Requirements:

Complete this application and attach the following:

- a) Proof of your eligibility to receive financial aid through FAFSA: apply at <http://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>
- b) Copy of high school diploma or General Education Diploma (GED) if graduated; **or** copy of current transcripts
- c) Two (2) letters of recommendation from a source outside your family (ex: clergy, teacher, employer, community organization leader)

Application Deadline:

Two hard copies of your completed application and attachments a-c listed above must be postmarked no later than **Monday, April 14, 2025**. **Only hard copies are accepted, no electronic transmissions.** Keep a copy, including this page, for your records and mail **two copies** to: **Impact Charity Services, PO Box 1692, Mt. Laurel, NJ 08054.**

Receiving Your Money:

If you are selected, your college/school of choice will receive a check directly. You will be given instructions in your spring congratulations letter about how to initiate this process. **A parental/legal guardian signature is required on this application declaring you understand 1) it will be *your* responsibility to initiate release of scholarship funds to your chosen institution; and 2) failure to initiate this release within six (6) months of award will result in forfeiture of scholarship.**
