• Experience growth as a musician/ performer.




Every Wednesday starting July 10th from 5:30 pm - 8 pm

- Students will take the 5:45 buses home





- Games are every Friday evening or Saturday Morning during the season.
- Report times will be announced the Sunday before the game
- Parents are strongly encouraged to attend
- For away games, we are usually back at the designated time
- We encourage students to call their parents when they are within 15 minutes of the school
- We perform pre-game at away games (20 minutes before the game starts) and halftime at home games. Special events are considered.
- Students will have the opportunity to eat at the concession stand during the game. Away games 1st quarter. Home games 3rd quarter.

COMPETITIONS

- We compete in the Tournament of Bands Circuit
- Competitions are on Saturday afternoons or evenings, some Sundays in October
- The schedule for the day is made available the Sunday before
- Some competitions are usually within an hour of the school. Except Hershey.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to attend competitions. It takes a village to make this activity successful. Parent Volunteers are needed.

What happens after the performance

- Students sit together in the visitor stands
- Students are permitted to purchase concessions
- The awards ceremony is at the end of the evening



We typically march in 5 parades:

- The Saturday before St. Patrick's Day in March Hamilton St. Patrick's
- May Township Parade and New Eygpt Memorial Day Parade
- 2nd Sat in June Columbus Field Day Parade
- June Wildwood Parade

Costs

- There is no fee to participate in the activity.
- Students are responsible for purchasing the marching shoes \$45, Guard Gloves \$20.

2 fundraisers will be made available for students






Comittment


